

Job description for Regional Checkers

The project



Working with 7 other national Disabled People's Organisations to capacity build 200 disabled people's organisations across England.

During the project, People First will work closely with 25 to 30 user led self advocacy groups for people with learning difficulties in England; to build their capacity, improve their diversity and make links with other disabled people's organisations in their area.



We will also work with 25 to 30 disabled people's organisations; to make sure that people with Learning Difficulties are heard at a regional and national level and included.



Ordinary place of work

This job will involve travel across the region and may include overnight stays in B & B's / hotels. You may be supported to do your work by your supporter.



Regional Checkers will be responsible for

With support you will be responsible for:



- Carrying out the audits which include a questionnaire, of disabled people's organisations to find out how they include people with learning difficulties.



- Keeping good records for the inclusion coordinator.
- Making sure information is shared and that information flows.



- Dealing with written and telephone enquiries relating to the regional checkers work.

You will be responsible for recruiting your own supporter.

- See how well they include people with learning difficulties in their work

- Has experience of self advocacy and/ or have experience of Disabled People's Organisations.

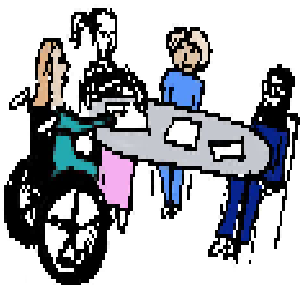


- Has the ability to develop new skills

- Has knowledge of the social model of disability.



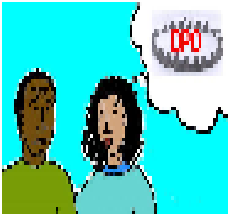
- Has an understanding of inclusion.
